# The Case Studies in Protection of Heritage

## The protection of the old town complex in Krosno, Poland

The protection of the old town complex in Krosno is performed by state offices and by the municipal government.

In its functions they are guided by the legal forms of protection of the historical urban layout and buildings of the historic city. Its skills also apply in financing the protection of monuments, in the restrictions on protection and development opportunities or in the possibilities of activities.



## The Museo Casa di Dante – Unione Fiorentina, Florence, Italy

The Museo Casa di Dante is the museum, among the those of the city of Florence, dedicated to the figure of the Italian poet Dante Alighieri and up to today, it is one of the most visited Florentine minor museums.

It is hosted in one of the city's most evocative buildings in Via Santa Margherita, 1, in the heart of the Medieval Florence. Its management is carried out by the Unione Fiorentina association and it will soon reopen after a complete refurbishment of all its spaces and expositions.



## Museu Monográfico de Conímbriga, Portugal

The Museu Monográfico de Conímbriga is a state archaeological museum dedicated to the history of the archaeological site of the ancient Roman city of Conímbriga, a place that had human occupation between the end of the second millennium before Christ and the sixth century of the Christian era.

The skills of the museum includes the protection of the ancient city of Conímbriga, the promotion of public exposure of the museum's archaeological collection and the pursuit of archaeological investigations. The museum's collection is exclusively composed of archaeological materials collected in archaeological interventions.
