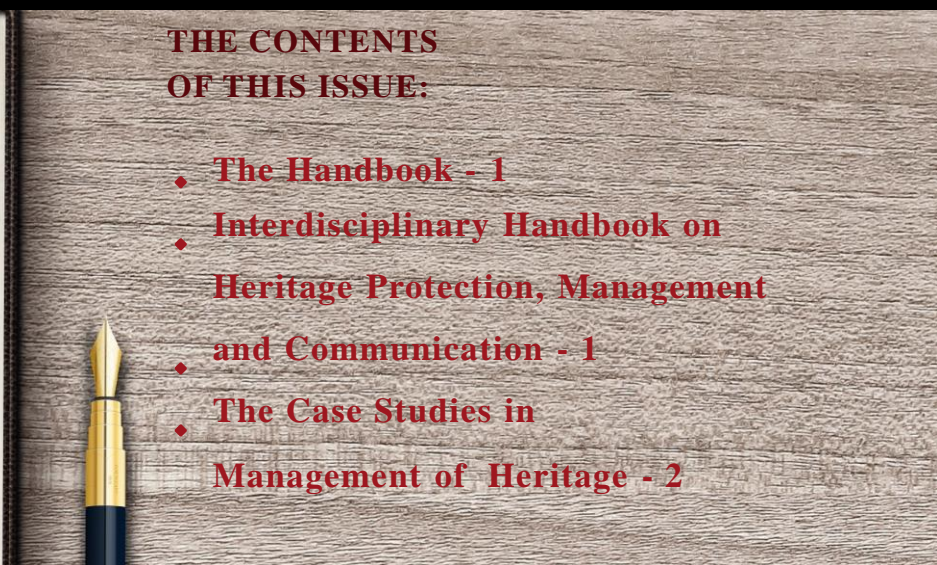


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**Interdisciplinary Handbook on Heritage Protection,

# The Case Studies in Management of Heritage

## Historic ruins of the castle in Janowiec, Poland

The management of the Castle of Janowiec includes the preservation of the historical values of the Castle, taking into account its patrimonial protection, problems related to the preservation of the ruins, the monitoring of its threats or problems related to its enjoyment and development. It also focuses on the cooperation of public or private stakeholders and facilitates the promotion of its tourism aspect.



## The Museo Casa di Dante – Unione Fiorentina, Florence, Italy

The Museo Casa di Dante is the museum, among the those of the city of Florence, dedicated to the figure of the Italian poet Dante Alighieri and up to today, it is one of the most visited Florentine minor museums.

It is hosted in one of the city's most evocative buildings in Via Santa Margherita, 1, in the heart of the Medieval Florence. Its management is carried out by the Unione Fiorentina association and it will soon reopen after a complete refurbishment of all its spaces and expositions.



## Fundação Côa Parque, Portugal

A Fundação Côa Parque manages the Vale do Côa Archaeological Park and the Côa Museum. The management includes the safeguarding, investigation, promotion, dissemination and public use of the heritage and natural resources of the Côa Valley, combining visits to the Museum with the rock art of Côa. The rock art of the Côa is a UNESCO World Heritage Site and one of the most important archaeological discoveries of the Upper Paleolithic in Europe.
