The Case Studies in Communication of Heritage

Wooden Architecture Route, Poland

The Wooden Architecture Route constitutes a recognized brand tourism product. It has good standards of cooperation and communication between various entities in the creation, development, promotion and presentation of the route, proven by the impact of the trail on the development of regional tourism.



The Fondazione Romualdo Del Bianco – Life Beyond Tourism, Italy

The Fondazione Romualdo Del Bianco is a private Florentine foundation dedicated to dialogue among cultures through heritage, travel and youth since over 30 years. Since 2007 it developed the research *Life Beyond Tourism - Travel to Dialogue*, that was developed through its network of over 500 institutions in 111 countries in the 5 continents. The research is aimed at creating opportunities of intercultural dialogue through travel, especially in World Heritage Sites, highly recognized as cultural destinations. The Foundation focused its activity in the communication of the cultural expressions and heritage (natural and cultural, tangible and intangible) through the Life Beyond Tourism Movement portal that promotes activities for territories preservation and communication.



Museu de Arte, Arquitetura e Tecnologia, Portugal

The Museum of Art, Architecture and Technology (MAAT) is a museum of contemporary art belonging to a private institution. It promotes critical discourse and creative practice, defending the concept of a museum as a catalyst for debate and transmission of knowledge.

It is located in an area that includes the museum, with bold architecture, and a converted thermoelectric power station - Central Tejo, an important building of industrial architecture - both connected by a garden in a dialogue between the past and the future.
